Thank-you for considering one of GW's Biomedical Laboratory Sciences clinical programs. As part of the decision making process, I am letting you know about certification and licensure requirements upon graduation from the program.

All students that graduate from our program are eligible to take national certification examinations, such as the American Society for Clinical Pathology (ASCP) Board of Certification (BOC). You can obtain more information about certification in the GW BLS Clinical Guide as well as during the practicum/clinical experience course(s) within your program of study. You can also obtain information on ASCP's website at <https://www.ascp.org/content/board-of-certification>. Certification is not required to graduate from this program nor is it required in every state, but it is recommended that you become certified.

In addition to certification, a few states in the United States require a license to practice as a laboratory scientist within that state. The states that require laboratory personnel licensure as of 2021 include California, Hawaii, Florida, New York, North Dakota, Tennessee, Louisiana, Nevada, West Virginia, Montana, Georgia, and Puerto Rico. To obtain a license in most states that have a licensure requirement, you are required to be nationally certified. However, two of the states, California (CA) and New York (NY), have additional requirements.

For example, California requires a longer clinical rotation than what is included in our program of study. Individuals from CA are allowed to extend their clinical rotations as long as the clinical facility approves, in order to meet the CA licensure requirement. Extending your clinical rotations will extend your program of study and extending your clinical rotations should be discussed with your clinical site and clinical coordinator as soon as possible to ensure uninterrupted progression in your program of study. All graduates from our program that have extended their clinical rotation and have applied for licensure have successfully obtained a CA license. In addition, students from CA need to apply for a training license before starting their rotations. However, military and veteran hospitals are exempt from this requirement.

NY requires individuals to have specific didactic courses, some of which are not included in your program of study. In addition, NY requires in-person laboratory courses that are not part of your program. NY also requires a longer clinical rotation than what is included in your program of study. Moreover, NY does not provide licensure to individuals with a categorical certification, they only provide licenses to individuals with MLS certification. Consequently, the GW program does not meet the NY state licensure requirements.

Our BLS programs produce graduates who are successfully certified and licensed in all states within the U.S. We have had graduates from NY or who have moved to NY after graduation that have successfully obtained state licensure. However, we have had graduates that have been turned down for licensure due to not meeting the NY education and training requirements.

If you would like more information about licensure, you should contact your state's licensure agency, especially if you live or are planning to work in a state that has specific licensure requirements such as CA and NY. It is the responsibility of each student to be informed about the licensure requirements for their state or the state they plan to work in.
